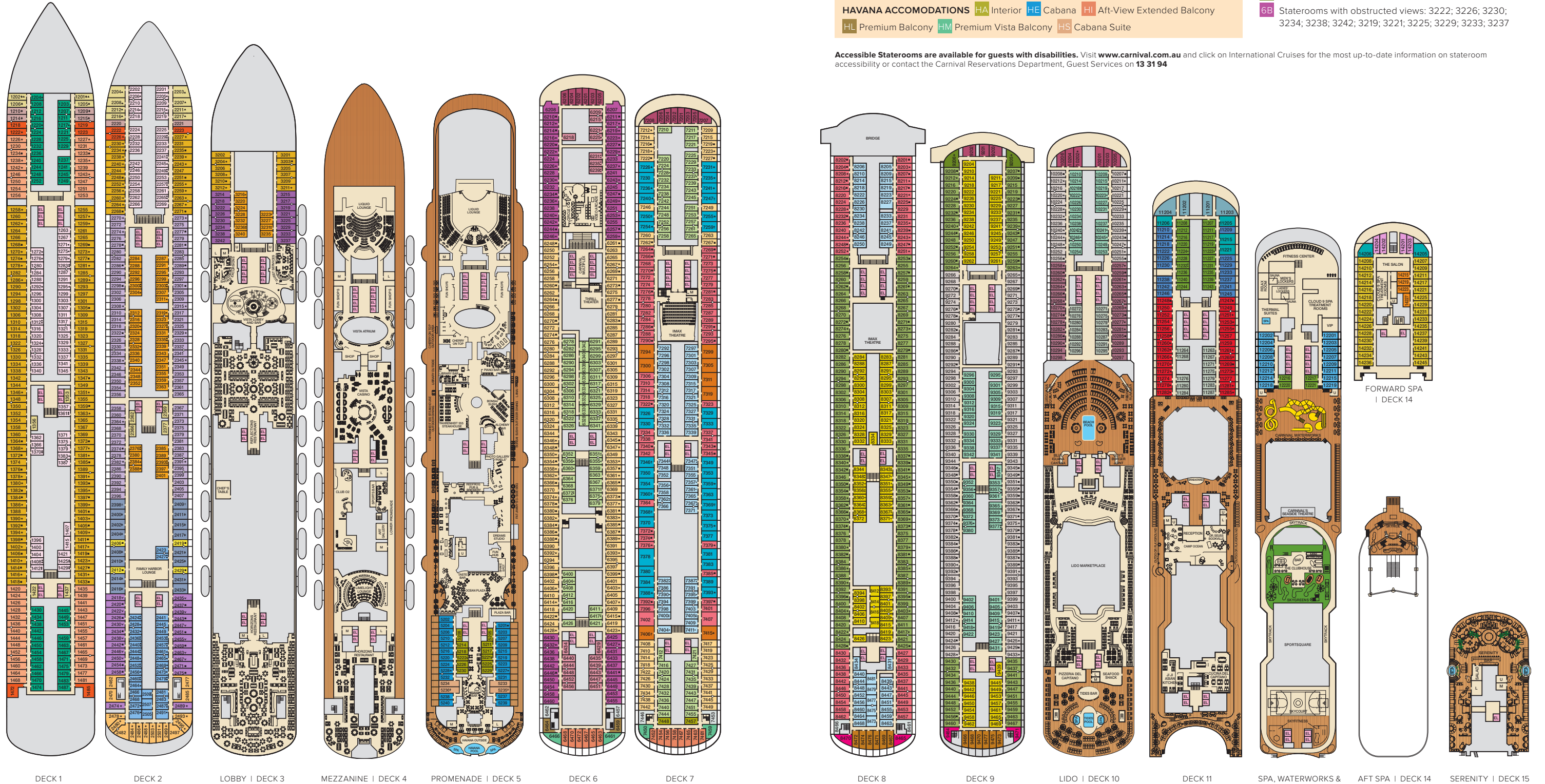

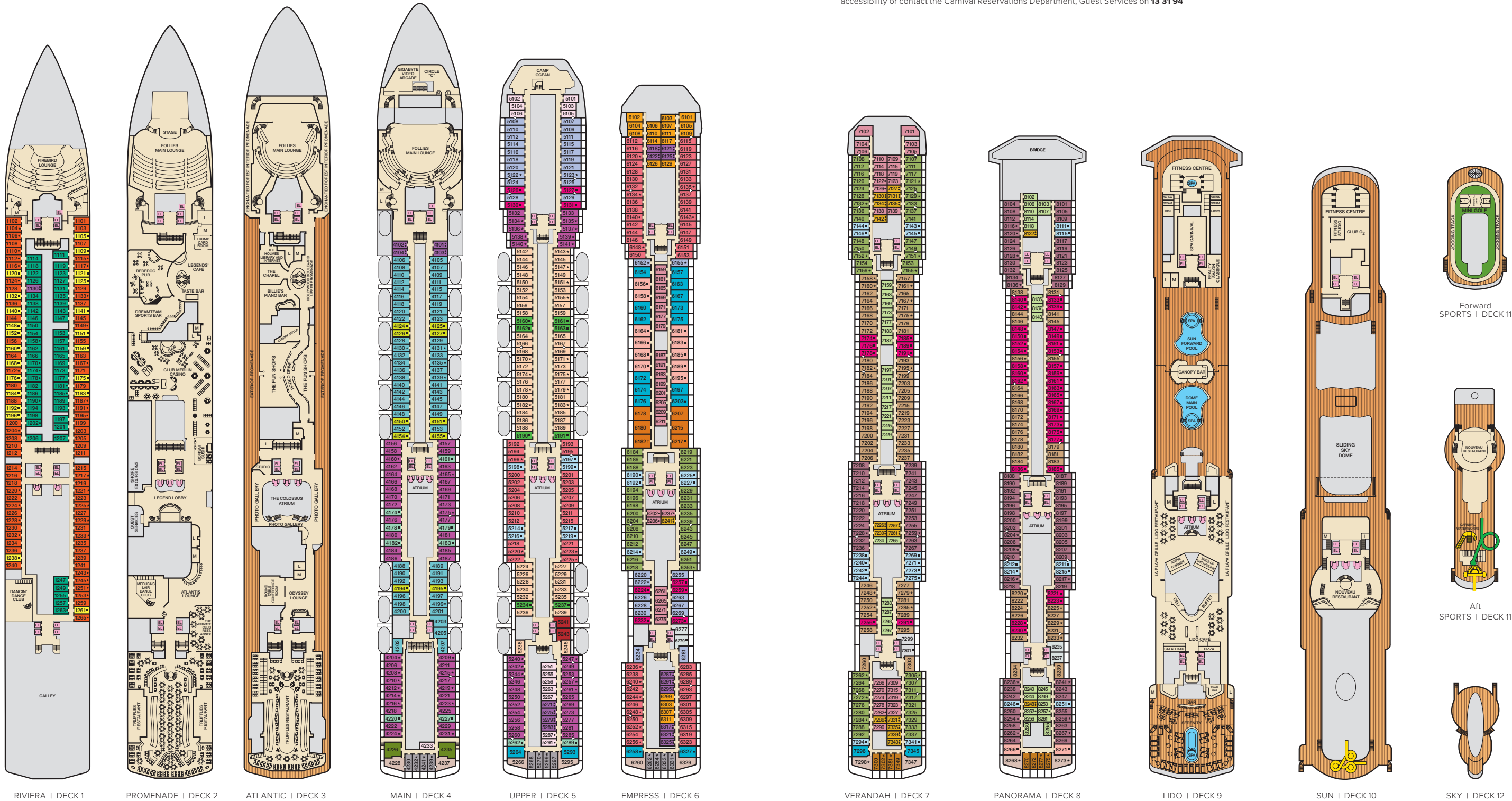

IMPORTANT BOOKING INFORMATION

ONLINE CHECK-IN ADVANCE REGISTRATION – U.S. BORDER SECURITY ACT
Carnival is required to provide the Department of Homeland Security with specific guest information and a final departure manifest, 60 minutes prior to the ship's departure. To comply, you must register in advance of your cruise by going to www.carnival.com/onlinecheckin. Please note that to log in or register, you will need your Carnival booking number, ship name and sail date, as well as the last name and date of birth of any one guest in the booking. To access your booking after logging in, select new cruise details followed by Online Check-In. If you have problems using Online Check-In, please contact Carnival. Failure to provide the information by 11:59pm EST, the day prior to your departure date will result in delays at embarkation and will require you to check in at the port at least 90 minutes prior to the published sailing time.

CRUISE DOCUMENTS, BOARDING PASS AND LUGGAGE TAGS
Upon completion of Online Check-In, you will be able to print your cruise documents, including luggage tags, boarding passes, and more. Additionally, within Cruise Details you will be able to view your reservation, purchase shore excursions, set your dining preferences, make spa appointments, and view Frequently Asked Questions, among other things. Guests using our Fly2Fun service can also access their flight information here.

ONBOARD & ONLINE PURCHASES
Generally, all onboard services and purchases made from our website are charged in USD, unless stated otherwise.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT
The following deposit is required in order to secure confirmed accommodations:
2&3 day cruises – \$100 per guest, balance payable no later than 60 days prior to departure date; **4 & 5 day cruises** – \$150 per guest, balance payable no later than 60 days prior to departure date; **6, 7, 8 & 9 day cruises** – \$250 per guest, balance payable no later than 75 days prior to departure date; **10 day or longer cruise** – \$400 per guest, balance payable no later than 90 days prior to departure; **Alaska/ Transatlantic/Panama Canal cruises** – \$400 per guest, balance payable no later than 90 days prior to departure. **All above amounts are in USD.**

CANCELLATION BY GUEST, REFUNDS
No refunds will be made in the event of "no shows", unused tickets, lost tickets, interruptions, partially used tickets, cancellations received late or after the start of the cruise, or for Pack & Go program purchases. Cancellation charges for individual bookings will be assessed as listed below. For cancellation charges related to group bookings, partial ship charters or full ship charters refer to your charter contract or group booking agreement for terms and conditions.

Bookings made December 2, 2015 and onwards, for sailings April 1, 2016 and onwards: **For cruises 5 days or less, the final payment date is 60 days prior to sailing, for 6-9 day cruises, the final payment date is 75 days prior to sailing and for cruises 10+ days, Alaska, Europe, Transatlantic and Panama Canal, the final payment date is 90 days prior to sailing.**

Once your booking is within our cancellation penalty period, the amount of penalty will increase as the cruise departure approaches. When calculating the days prior to sailing, the day of sailing should not be considered as one of the days. The day of sailing is considered the first day of the cruise.

From the final payment date to 56 days prior to sailing (or 46 days prior to sailing for cruises 5 days or less), the penalty is the **deposit amount**.

From 55-30 days prior to sailing (or 45-30 days prior to sailing on cruises 5 days or less), the penalty is **50%** of the total fare or the deposit amount, whichever is greater.

From 29-15 days prior to sailing, the penalty is **75%** of the total fare or the deposit amount, whichever is greater.

From 14 days prior to sailing to the day of your cruise, the penalty is **100%*** of the total fare.

No refunds will be made if you do not show up for your cruise or if you interrupt or cancel your holiday once it has begun.

*Note: For full 100% penalties, the refund will ONLY include: Taxes, Fees and Port Expenses and Optional Prepaid Gratuities.

MINOR GUESTS
Standard booking rates apply for minors. Guests under the age of 21 years must

travel with a relative or guardian 25 years or older. Exceptions include legally married couples and qualified military personnel. For both exceptions, proof is required. Documentation can be e-mailed to individualsailingsupport@carnival.com. Failure to provide documentation or not conforming to this policy will result in denied boarding and no compensation will be provided. Infants must be at least six months old (12 months for Transatlantic, Hawaii and Transpacific) to be eligible to travel. Please note that adult guests are responsible at all times for the safety and behaviour of their minor guests. When minors (18 and under) are not traveling with a relative, we strongly recommend bringing an original signed letter from the absent parent/ legal guardian authorising the minor to travel. This will expedite processing by the Department of Homeland Security. Guests under the age of 21 staying at any hotel in conjunction with Carnival's Fly2Fun program or vacation packages may be required to be accompanied by a guest 21 years or older in the same room as per each hotel's policy. Permission for minor guests to fly unaccompanied is determined by the airlines as per each airline's rules. Guests should check with their scheduled airline for eligibility. Carnival assumes no responsibility for unaccompanied guests under 21 years of age traveling by air. Carnival's youth programs feature supervised activities for kids and teens ages 2-17. Guests must be 18 or older to visit the onboard casino; teens 12-17 years of age may use Spa Carnival and the fitness centre if accompanied by a parent or guardian. Guests younger than 21 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol.

PREGNANCY
While at sea or in port, the availability of medical care may be limited or delayed. Carnival denies any responsibility or liability for late arrival of your flight or train or for any illness, injury, damage, loss of cruise time or other irregularities resulting therefrom. Carnival's responsibility does not extend beyond the vessel. You are responsible for arriving at the respective ports on time for embarkation and for joining the vessel at its next port of call if, for any reason, you miss a scheduled sailing. Carnival reserves the right to refuse or discontinue passage to anyone when, in Carnival's judgment, it would be considered a risk to the guest's own safety and well-being or the health, safety, wellbeing, comfort and enjoyment of any other guest or crew member. Cruise passage is subject to the terms and conditions shown on Carnival Cruise Line "Terms and Conditions of Passage Contract Ticket," including the procedure for the resolution of disputes, which must take place in Miami-Dade County, Florida. VISA & PASSPORT INFORMATION
Non-U.S. citizens require a valid machine readable passport and a valid, unexpired U.S. Multiple entry visa, if applicable, to travel on all Carnival cruises. Guests are advised to check with their consulate, travel agent or appropriate government authority to determine the necessary documents. Non-U.S. citizens that are eligible to apply for admission under the Visa Waiver Pilot Program, must still have a valid unexpired passport. U.S. State Department regulations require all guests traveling from visa-waiver countries be in possession of a machine-readable passport that includes a biometric identifier - e.g., embedded digital photograph. Otherwise, guests will be required to obtain a U.S. Multiple entry visa. Guests without proper identification may be refused boarding or entry into the United States. On occasion, non-U.S. citizens and U.S. Alien Residents may be asked to surrender their passport and/or Alien Resident Card at time of embarkation. These documents will be returned upon completion of the Immigration inspection at the time of debarkation.

SMOKING POLICY
All cabins and suite accommodations are entirely smoke free, including the outside balcony.
